CrimeView Helps Hartford Police Implement Change in Laws

The Hartford Police Department in Connecticut was recently able to use CrimeView® to help enact a change in the local vehicle registration laws. Quite a few registrations were being stolen from license plates and CrimeView's mapping and analysis tools were able to depict the pattern of these crimes geographically.

“We have demonstrated the CrimeView application to several state and local public safety officials, all who comment, that they have never seen such a robust crime mapping system. Using the desktop application, our

Crime Analysis Division created a map displaying the location of incidents for every stolen license plate within the city for a two year period. This map was presented to the Connecticut legislature and was instrumental in changing state regulations governing motor vehicle registration stickers. Presently we are developing a map that will be used by city officials as evidence to enact a new city ordinance governing twenty-four hour convenience stores.”
